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AMENDMENT TO  
  
AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN  
  
THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS

GRANICUS, INC.

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made and entered into as of the July 31, 2011 by and between Granicus, Inc. (“Granicus”), a California Corporation represented by Ed Roshitsh, its Chief Operating Officer, and the City of New Orleans, herein represented by the City Council President, Jacquelyn B. Clarkson (collectively referred to herein as the “Parties”).

**WITNESSETH**

**WHEREAS**, on September 20, 2007, the City Council adopted Motion M-07-450, determining that professional services were required to design, implement and maintain a Computerized Web Video Streaming and Meetings Management System and directing its staff to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to begin the competitive selection process established by Council Rule 45: and

**WHEREAS**, a Request for Proposals for the design, implementation and maintenance of a computerized Web Video Streaming and Meetings Management System for the City Council was issued on September 24, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Motion M-08-413, the City Council authorized the President of the Council to sign a contract with Granicus, Inc. for a Computerized Web Video Streaming and Meetings Management System. Said contract was effective on July 31, 2008; and

1           **WHEREAS**, on November 6, 2008, the City Council adopted Motion M-08-609  
2 authorizing a contract amendment with Granicus, Inc. in order to clarify the scope of work  
3 to include all necessary electrical material, work and services, and to correspondingly  
4 increase the contract amount to reflect such clarification; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the aforementioned contract with Granicus, Inc. expired on July 30,  
6 2009; and

7           **WHEREAS**, according to the aforementioned contract with Granicus, Inc., the  
8 contract may be extended at the option of the Council, on an annual basis for no longer  
9 than five one-year periods, provided that funds are allocated by the New Orleans City  
10 Council and the extension of the contract facilitates the continuity of services provided; and

11           **WHEREAS**, on November 5, 2009, the City Council adopted Motion M-09-585  
12 authorizing a contract extension with Granicus, Inc. for an additional annual period from  
13 July 31, 2009 until July 30, 2010, to provide for the continuation of services provided  
14 therein; and

15           **WHEREAS**, the aforementioned contract extension with Granicus, Inc. expired on  
16 July 30, 2010; and

17           **WHEREAS**, on August 12, 2010, the City Council adopted Motion M-10-346  
18 authorizing a contract extension with Granicus, Inc. for an additional annual period from  
19 July 31, 2010 until July 30, 2011, to provide for the continuation of services provided  
20 therein; and

21           **WHEREAS**, the aforementioned contract extension with Granicus, Inc. will  
22 expire on July 30, 2011; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the Council desires to authorize a contract extension with Granicus,  
2 Inc. for an additional annual period from July 31, 2011 until July 30, 2012, to provide for  
3 the continuation of services provided therein; and

4           **WHEREAS**, by Motion M-11-305 adopted on July 8, 2011, the President of the  
5 Council is hereby authorized to sign a contract extension with Granicus, Inc., for an  
6 additional annual period from July 31, 2011 until July 30, 2012, to provide for the  
7 continuation of services provided therein; and

8           **WHEREAS**, all parties to the agreements desire to extend the agreement and have  
9 the necessary authority to do so; and

10           **NOW, THEREFORE** the parties do agree as follows:

11           To continue the services provided in the aforementioned contract by extending the  
12 term of the contract for an additional annual period from July 31, 2011 until July  
13 30, 2012 and rewording lines 12 to 17 of page 16 of 31 of the Agreement dated July  
14 13, 2008 to read as follows:


1 The services to be provided under the terms of this Agreement shall begin on the

6 this Agreement.




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

Spengler, its Chief Executive Officer, and the City of New Orleans, represented by the City Council President, Jacquelyn Brechtel Clarkson, (collectively referred to herein as the “Parties”) signed a contract for professional services; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 6, 2008, the City Council adopted Motion M-08-609 authorizing a contract amendment with Granicus, Inc. in order to clarify the scope of work to include all necessary electrical material, work and services, to correspondingly increase the contract amount to the maximum compensation, in the aggregate, of Three Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Four and 62/100 Dollars (\$362,374.62), and to provide for the payment of the said increased amount; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforementioned contract expired on July 30, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, according to the aforementioned contract with Granicus, Inc., the contract may be extended at the option of the Council, on an annual basis for no longer than five one-year periods, provided funds are allocated by the New Orleans City Council and the extension of the contract facilitates the continuity of services provided; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 5, 2009, the City Council adopted Motion M-09-585 authorizing a contract extension with Granicus, Inc. for an additional annual period from July 31, 2009 until July 30, 2010, to provide for the continuation of services provided therein; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforementioned contract with Granicus, Inc. expired on July 30, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 12, 2010, the City Council adopted Motion M-10-346 authorizing a contract extension with Granicus, Inc. for an additional annual period from July 31,

2010 until July 30, 2011, to provide for the continuation of services provided therein; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforementioned contract extension with Grancius, Inc. will expire on July 30, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties mutually desire to extend the aforementioned contract for professional services for an additional annual period from July 31, 2011 until July 30, 2012 to provide for the continuation of services provided therein; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council desires to authorize a contract extension with Granicus, Inc. for an additional annual period from July 31, 2011 until July 30, 2012 to provide for the continuation of services provided therein; now, therefore

**BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS**, that the President of the Council is hereby requested and authorized to sign a contract extension with Granicus, Inc. for an additional annual period from July 31, 2011 until July 30, 2012 to provide for the continuation of services provided therein.
